Please remember the following restrictions when it comes to holiday lights and décor:

• No lights or decorations of any kind are permitted to be installed on or placed in the easement area abutting the Lot. The easement area is the grassed area between the roadway and the sidewalk in front of the Lot (where the mailbox is). This includes the street trees in the easement area. No lights or decorations are permitted on any street tree.



- No lights or decorations of any kind are permitted to be installed on or over the sidewalks in the community. This includes archways or other items that are positioned on or over the sidewalks. This also includes all electrical cords, light strands and all other devices/items that would be placed on or over the sidewalk.
- The sidewalks are shared common areas that are used by many individuals in the community, and we need to ensure all sidewalks are clear of all items to pedestrians can travel on them safely and unobstructed.

Here are some decorating guidelines:

- Before you get all tangled in Christmas lights and perch precariously on the ladder, take some time to plan out your Christmas lights design.
- Check that lights and cords are in good repair and are rated

for outdoor use.

- Read manufacturer recommendations to determine the number of lights you can safely string together.
- Outdoor lights should be plugged into circuits protected by ground-fault circuit interrupters (GFCIs).
